Friday is Community Service Update and Planning Day.

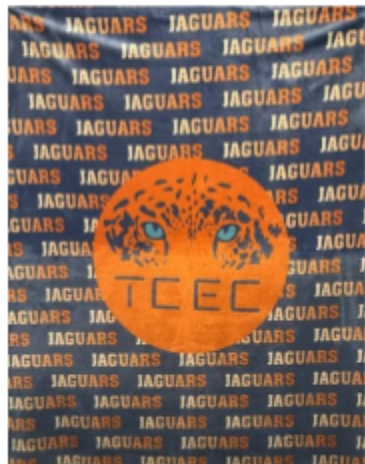
The overnight trip to Wake Forest Medical Center this Thursday and Friday, February 20-21 has been postponed. A new date will be announced soon.
